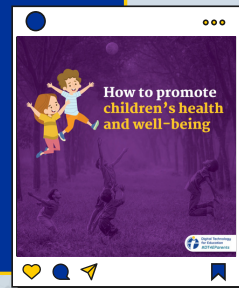
DT4E/Parents offers a **free, downloadable collection of learning materials** especially designed for **parents of K to 12 learners**.

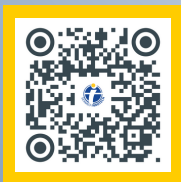
