

HOW DO WE SET UP AN EIE PROGRAM?



BEFORE

CAPACITATE

Clarify roles and build capabilities of teachers, school heads, and other education stakeholders on EiE implementation.

ORGANIZE

- * Assemble EiE task teams.
- * Prepare go-kits, and pre-position temporary learning spaces (TLS) and alternative learning materials.
- Make twinning agreements with neighboring divisions and regions.

Just remember: CAPACITATE,

ORGANIZE,

RESPOND,

REPRESENT & REPORT



AFTER

RESPOND

- * Conduct damage reports.
- * Set up registration, information, and TLS.
- * Conduct head count for teachers and learners.
- * Conduct psychosocial and well-being interventions.
- * Provide information to learners and parents and implement alternative education pathways.
- * Maintain database of affected teachers, learners and extent of damage, etc. for monitoring and reporting.
- * Establish and maintain monitoring and information boards.

REPRESENT & REPORT

- * Participate in meetings with local disaster risk management (DRM) groups.
- * Provide reports and updates.
