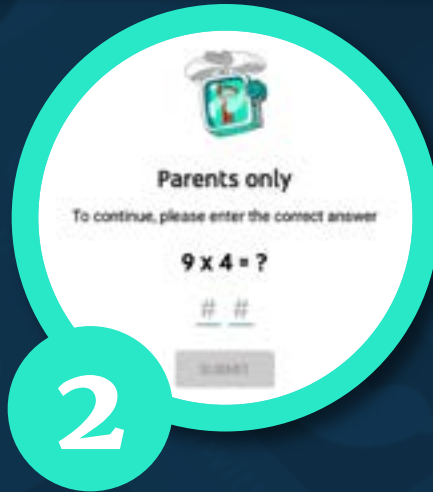

and modify it according to how you want to customize your kid's viewing experience.

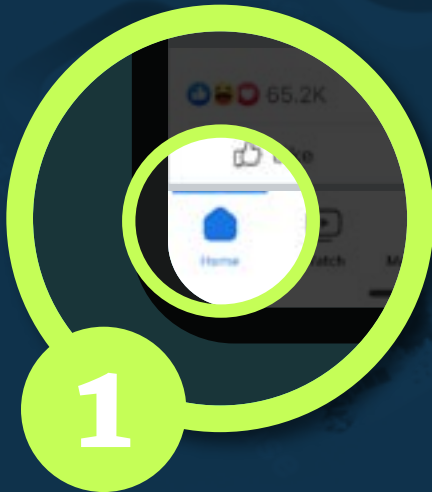

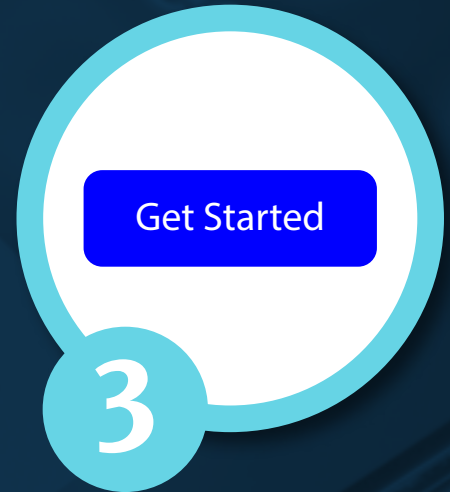
Messenger Kids

Tap the left-hand menu and navigate to Messenger Kids.

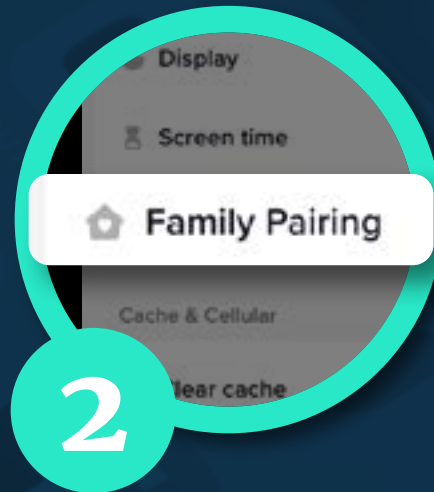


Get started. Supervise your kid's Facebook interactions, manage the images they post, and control their screen time.

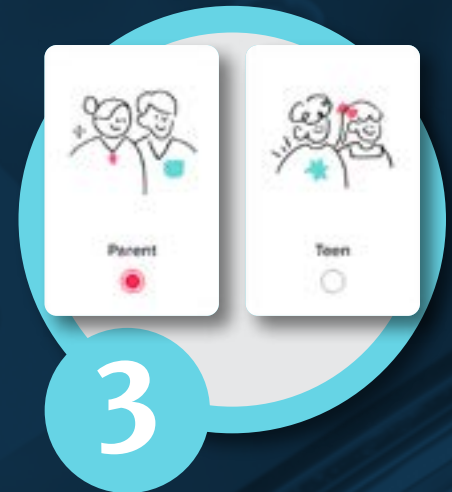
Activating Family Pairing in



Tap on your profile and then on the three dots in the top-right corner, which takes you to the **Settings and Privacy** menu.



If you scroll down, you should see the **Family Pairing** section.



After tapping on it, you should be able to choose whether you are the **parent** or the **teen** and connect your accounts.

Controlling unexpected purchases in

ROBLOX



To prevent unexpected purchases charged to your card and to protect your kid's safety:

Tap the three dots located in the lower-right corner of the page.

In the pop-up menu, select the **Settings** option and then choose **Security**.

In the **Account Restrictions** section, press the toggle button.

Select a PIN to prevent unchecked purchases and manage other security measures.
